Notice of the Adoption of an Official Plan

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Bruce Mines adopted an Official Plan by By-law No. 2012-34 on September 4, 2012, under Section 17 of the Planning Act, RSO 1990.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The Town of Bruce Mines is required to review its Official Plan every five years. As a result of the review and the requirements of the Planning Act, Council has revised its Official Plan. The Official Plan sets out policies for residential and non-residential development in the Town, shore line management and waterfront development, home based businesses, community improvement, natural resource management (minerals, mineral aggregates, water, wildlife habitat), municipal services and infrastructure, economic development, protection against hazardous lands (mine workings, flood prone lands and contaminated lands). The effect will be to encourage and provide for growth and development within the Town over the next 20 years that is sustainable and serviced.

Official Plan: Any person or public body is entitled to receive notice of the decision of the approval authority (Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing) if a written request to be notified of the decision is made to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing, 159 Cedar Street, Suite 401, Sudbury, Ontario P3E 6A5.
