# BEING A BYLAW TO SET FEES FOR TRUNK ROAD CEMETERY AND TAYLOR STREET CEMETERY IN THE TOWN OF BRUCE MINES

WHEREAS Municipalities under the *Bereavement Authority of Ontario* and the *Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002* are empowered to establish, regulate and operate cemeteries within their jurisdiction;

**AND WHEREAS** the Corporation of the Town of Bruce Mines deems it necessary to pass a bylaw to set fees for the two cemeteries operated under the Town of Bruce Mines Cemetery Board, namely:

Taylor Street Cemetery
Trunk Road Cemetery

**NOW THEREFORE** the Corporation of the Town of Bruce Mines ENACTS as follows:

### SECTION A: SCHEDULE OF FEES

## **FULL SIZE BURIAL LOTS:**

Land \$100.00

Care and Maintenance: \$250.00

(Perpetual Care)

Transfer \$ 10.00

# **OPENING AND CLOSING**

Cremation Site \$100.00

Traditional Site \$500.00

# **INSTALLATION OF MARKERS:**

Flat markers less than 173 inches squared: Nil

Flat marker larger than 173 inches squared: \$ 100.00

Upright markers less than 4' x 4': \$200.00

Upright markers measuring four (4) feet or more in height or length, including base

\$400.00

No contribution if the marker is installed to replace a marker that has been damaged and cannot be repaired.

100% allocated to care and maintenance fund for all marker fees as set out in O/Regulation 130/11.

# DISINTERMENT CHARGES

All disinterments will be done in accordance with the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act.

Disinterment of burial

\$2,000.00

Disinterment of cremated remains

\$ 350.00

## **SECTION B: EFFECTIVE DATE**

- 1. This Bylaw shall repeal all bylaws previously passed for this purpose.
- 2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon its approval by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario.
